Tell your Westlake Lutheran/New Hope Story

Do not write on the timeline on the wall.

This packet includes an envelope full of stickers, a double-sided page to write on and a sheet protector.

Write your name at the top of the page and put an initial on the stickers. Note that initial next to your name.

The stickers match the dots and crosses on the page. Think about your time at Westlake Lutheran/New Hope. Just like at times we've done "highs and lows" in our family and our church family, think about the high points (green dots) and low or more challenging points (red dots.)

Choose the place in the timeline on the Social Hall wall where you want them. Make a note on your sheet about where you put them, and why.

Do the same thing with the silver dots, marking church events were your absolute favorite things ever in your story as part of the congregation. Maybe, if you've been here that long, it was the day in May 1972 that you or someone in your family signed the charter. Maybe, if you've been here only in the last year or so, it was when you found New Hope on YouTube or went to your first in-person service.

You also have four gold crosses. Put these on the timeline where your (or your family's) <u>most</u> memorable religious events took place. Maybe it was a baptism, or confirmation, or joining the congregation. Maybe someone had their First Communion, or there was a wedding. Or maybe you said goodbye to a loved one with a Celebration of Life.
