Confession of Sin

Hymn

P: Let us confess our sin in the presence of God and of one another.

Silence is kept for reflection and self-examination.

- P: Most holy and merciful God,
- All: we confess to you and to one another, and before the whole company of heaven, that we have sinned by our fault, by our own fault, by our own most grievous fault, in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done and by what we have left undone.
- P: We have not loved you with our whole heart, and mind, and strength. We have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We have not forgiven others as we have been forgiven.

All: Have mercy on us, O God.

P: Our neglect of human need and suffering, and our indifference to injustice and cruelty, we confess to you.

All: Have mercy on us, O God.

P: Our waste and pollution of your creation, and our lack of concern for those who come after us, we confess to you.

All: Have mercy on us, O God.

P: Restore us, O God, and let your anger depart from us.

All: Hear us, O God, for your mercy is great.

Absolution

P: God hears our prayers and grants us forgiveness. Your sins are forgiven. Find peace in this forgiveness.
