Around the throne of glory the Lamb they shall behold; in triumph cast before him their diadems of gold.


Our hope and expectation, O Jesus, now appear; arise, O Sun so longed for, o'er this benighted sphere.

and Aram the father of Aminadab, and Aminadab the father of Nahshon, and Nahshon the father of Salmon,

and Salmon the father of Boaz by Rahab, and Boaz the father of Obed by Ruth, and Obed the father of Jesse, and Jesse the father of King David.

And David was the father of Solomon by the wife of Uriah, and Solomon the father of Rehoboam, and Rehoboam the father of Abijah,

and Abijah the father of Asaph, and Asaph the father of Jehoshaphat, and Jehoshaphat the father of Joram, and Joram the father of Uzziah,

So all the generations from Abraham to David are fourteen generations; and from David to the deportation to Babylon, fourteen generations;
